

Architecture Tour on Tram

Operating since 1904, the tram is Hong Kong's oldest public transport which witnesses the development of Hong Kong for the last 100 years. Taking you on a tram ride that meanders through some of the oldest and most prosperous neighbourhoods, a qualified architect and a historian will guide you through the development history of Hong Kong along the tramway and show you the unique architecture of some of the landmark and historical buildings: the Western and Central Markets, the Court of Final Appeal, St John's Cathedral, the Legislative Council Chambers, the Hong Kong Club, the Chater Garden, Bank of China building, old Wanchai, The Hong Kong Jockey Club Museum, Craigengower Cricket Club, St Margaret's Church, Happy Valley Racecourse, the Times Square and many more.
