Questioning Engagement: Invoking Ethics In and Through Cinema

Cultural Studies' theoretical flashpoint might best be described as a perpetually evolving corpus of concepts and ideas that has been driven to critically reflect on itself so as to generate the kernel of a disciplinary ethic. Cinema ethics, on the other hand, are understood as the myriad lessons offered by aesthetic adaptations of the moving image in relation or response to its unstable conditions.
