Inferences With Respect To The Place Of The Frankfurt School Particular To Culture Industry Approach Against Communication Approaches

Adorno and Horkheimer had preffered the culture industry concept instead of some other concepts. Culture provides a repertoire of humanizing values in contrast to industry. Culture industry as a social control device is a culture that is imposed and governed by the authority. Today culture makes everything resemble to each other. Cinema, radio and magazines constitute a system. Each field adapts with the fields in it and inter-fields.
