In the realm of existence, the basic question that women face is the questioning of “subject” and “subjectivity.” In its basic form, her intellectual, emotional and demonstrative existence or her subjectivity in different ages and cultures are those that are mostly related to all areas of economic, social, political and cultural relations and that are known mostly through her needs, interests and importance. This research has been conducted through the use of a previously prepared form on 3,500 women in 8 provinces in Turkey.
