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**Modernities in the Future Tense**

In at least some parts of the world, and in many of their overlapping spaces, the contemporary conjuncture(s) might be constructed as problem spaces of modernity itself—as struggles over the possibility of a multiplicity of ways of being modern. Such a project for imagining other futures that might include other modernities requires us to think both conjuncturally and ontologically, to forge a new diagram of modernity that does not reduce its potentiality to the actuality of North Atlantic history.
