## **Old Central Walking Tour**

In collaboration with the SEE Network, an NGO devoted to the conservation of the culture of Hong Kong, the tour will start from Possession Street and Hollywood Road, the starting point of British colonial rule, and take you though some of the most historical places of Hong Kong including: Tai Ping Shan Street, the Chinese community in the early colonial period; Man Mo Temple, the worshipping centre of the Chinese in the 19<sup>th</sup> century; Wing Lee Street, the last authentic Hong Kong neighborhood saved from the bulldozer of urban re-development by the award winning film *Echoes Of The Rainbow*, Upper Lascar Row, famous for its antique shops; the former Central Police Station and Victoria Prison, where Dr Sun Yat-sen leader of the Chinese Revolution to overthrow the Qing Dynasty was allegedly detained; Graham Street Market, Hong Kong oldest street market and many more. This 2-hour walking tour requires considerable walking up and down the old Central district which was developed along the hill slope.
